

Watch Meeting Minutes (04/08/15)

Board proposal package for the June Clean up event was submitted to the board.

Clean up event

- Identified May 9 for the event date. (May 23 for a rain date.)
- This is to avoid overlap with the community yard sale on the initially suggested date, which was May 16.
- We will not be moving forward with the shred truck. May pursue this at a future event.
- Adopt a highway sponsorship
 - Proposed that we work with adopt a highway to provide materials.
 - Unfortunately, they requested a 10 year commitment, which we determined was too much.
 - So we will not be pursuing this, at this point in time.
- Areas to focus for clean up:
 - Section A: Hidden Oak & Timbercross, behind the mailboxes.
 - Question as to whether or not we can/should go into the light woods that are designated as "conservation area".
 - (Action: Andre) Ask Randy, and our County rep, if there's any information about restrictions.
- Board discussion
 - We will be going to the board with the proposal prior to requesting the release of fund, which have been approved and allocated for this event.
 - This review will happen at the next board meeting, April 14 at 7:00 pm at the Clubhouse.
 - Luke will lead the proposal, and requests that at least one Watch member attend.
 - (Action:) Attend the meeting to answer questions.
- Dumpster reservation
 - 10 yard dumpster
 - Cannot place "hazardous" materials. (Includes tires, chemicals.) Will notify participants that they're not to touch these kinds of items.
 - Dumpster will be picked up at 2:00 pm sharp.
- Supplies
 - Trash bags (distinctive, if available)
 - Gloves
 - Vests
 - Water
 - Snacks
 - Dumpster
 - First Aid Kit
 - (Action: Andre) Ask Randy if there is an existing first aid kit that's available.
- Request to share phone numbers.
- Goals, based on volunteer numbers
 - Meager: Two playgrounds
 - Modest: Two playgrounds, and front entrance
- Strategy for coordination
 - Breakdown the neighborhood into a grid

- Make a prioritized list, and send volunteers to the next location when finished with a site.

Discussion about dog park, basketball court, tennis courts usage from non-residents.

- Add this to the agenda at our next meeting.

Mike collected crime stats. Will update his spreadsheet and circulate.

- These numbers are for Tanyard Springs and Creekside. (Single police district.)

Also add agenda item for discussing the "official" national neighborhood watch program for next agenda.
